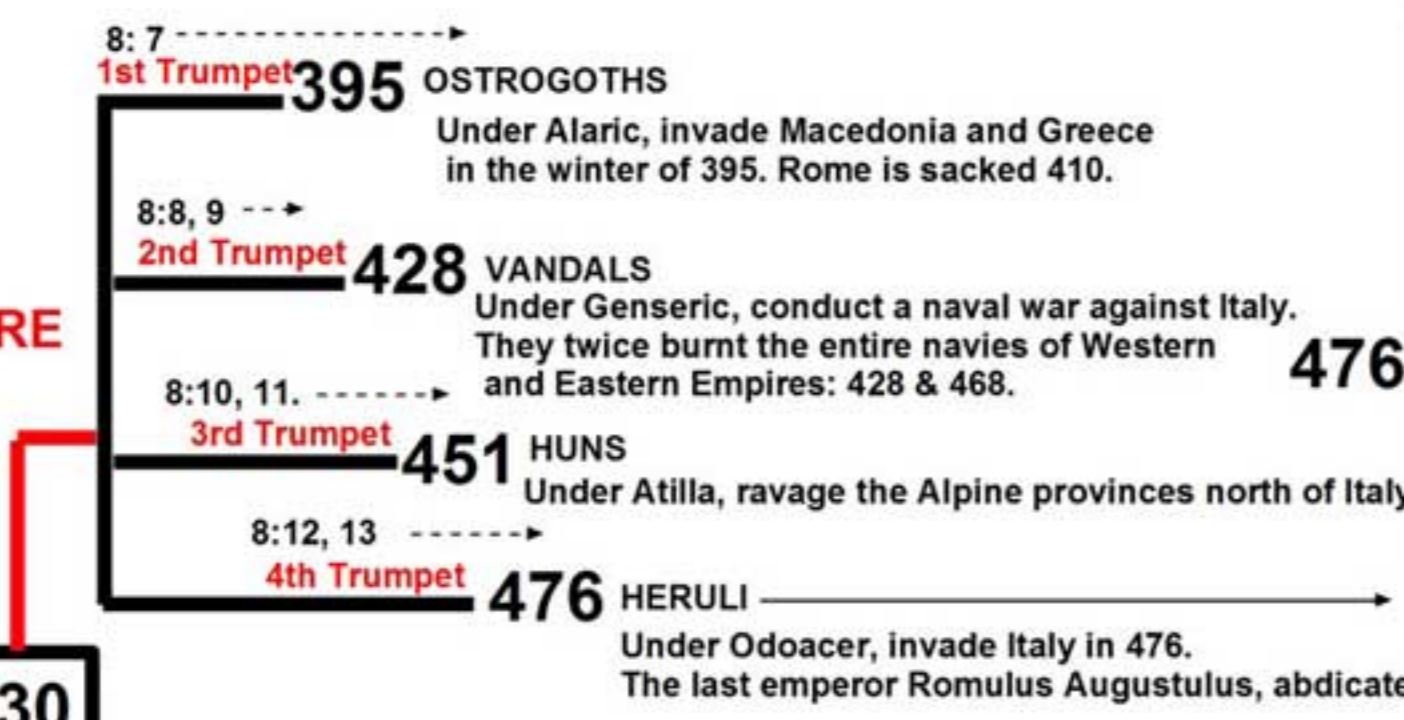


Rev.8: 2 - 5 These preliminary scenes in the first and second apartments of the heavenly sanctuary portray events in heaven which climax with the coming of Christ.

signifies that Christ's ministration in the heavenly sanctuary comes to an end.



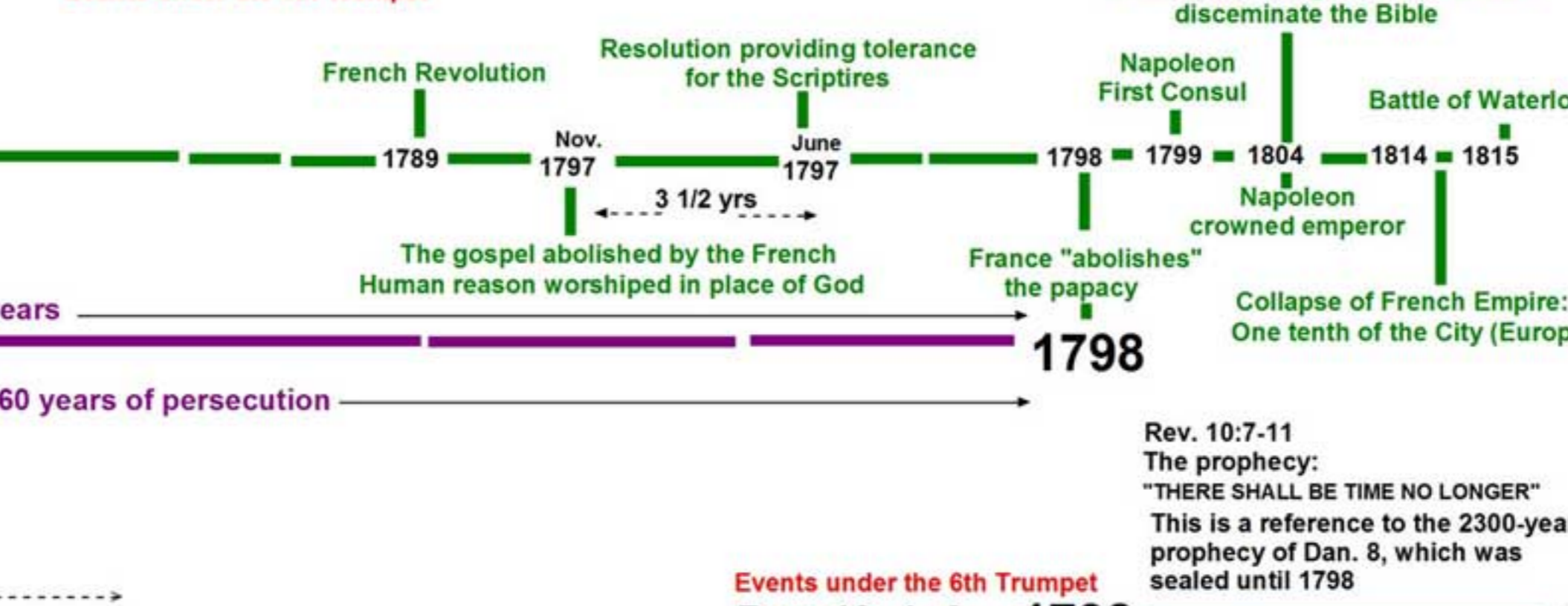
THE NATIONS OF EUROPE AND THE PAPAL LITTLE HORN EMERGE OUT OF THE WESTERN EMPIRE
